

## NOTICE OF RAILROAD CROSSING VIOLATION

This <u>warning</u> letter is part of an educational effort led by the City of Orlando and Federal Railroad Administration to advise you of a dangerous driving behavior. The pictures on this educational notice show a vehicle registered to you engaged in this dangerous and illegal driving behavior. This is a violation of F.S. 316.1575 and/or 316.1576. According to national statistics, 96% of all rail-related fatalities and injuries occur at highway rail-grade crossings or while trespassing on railroad property, and most of these collisions can be prevented. According to Florida Statutes, a vehicle must:

- · Stop at least 15 feet from a rail crossing when signal lights are activated, and
- · Not enter the crossing without sufficient space to drive completely through the crossing.

As motorists, we need to always be prepared to stop at the crossing; slow down, look both ways, and listen; obey warning devices; and check that you have enough room on the other side of the tracks for your vehicle to cross safely. Finally, you should never race a train, and never stop on tracks.

Through the City of Orlando, Orlando STOPS railroad educational campaign, in collaboration with the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Railroad Administration and SunRail, we are working to increase awareness of this dangerous driving behavior. We appreciate you working to improve traffic safety by informing other drivers of these important rules.
